Police Report- This Thursday, Columbus will have their shop with a cop. Chief met with GBI on our summer ATM robbery case for 2 individuals from out of state. The arson suspect has been identified and thanks to social media and Facebook. He will also have the end of the year report at the next meeting.

Budget- Councilor Howard made a motion to approve 2024 Budget, Mayor Pro-Tem Whearley 2nd the motion. Vote unanimous.
